The main responsibility of the manufacturing technician is to support production and development staff with operation of various technical equipment. Typical responsibilities include:

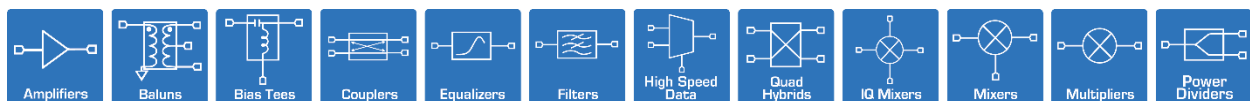
- Support design engineering staff to generate drawings and place orders for R&D materials
- Perform laser marking of Marki products and maintenance of laser marking equipment
- Modify, and maintain Laser AutoCAD drawings
- Operate Pick and Place machine
- Perform conductive paint on electronic components
- Assist engineering staff in production and prototyping of products including these: running experiments, testing, tuning, etc.
- Assist in facilities' maintenance to help ensure upkeep of capital equipment for production and R&D
- Some Computer Skills desired (Strong computer skills is preferred)
- AUTOCAD is strongly preferred
- Perform RF electrical tests under the guidance of engineering staff
- Other Duties as assigned
